S.R.O. - In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and supersession of the Armed Forces Medical Store Depot, Recruitment Rules, 2005 and 2006, relate to the posts of Senior Store Superintendent and Store Superintendent, now merged and re-designated as Senior Store Superintendent, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Store Superintendent in the Directorate General Armed Forces Medical Services, Ministry of Defence, namely:-

**(1) Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Defence, Directorate General Armed Forces Medical Services, (Group 'B' posts) Senior Store Superintendent, "Recruitment Rules, 2018".

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.** - The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to this notification.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.** -The method of recruitment for the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person, -

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.

5. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**Promotion.**

Superintendent(Store) in the Level-4, (Rs. 25500-81100) having 10 year regular service in the grade.

Note:-

Where juniors who have completed their qualifying /eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying/eligibility service, by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade alongwith their juniors who have already completed such qualifying/eligibility service.

Deputation:

Officers under the Central Government:

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre/Department, or  
(ii) with 10 year service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in post in the Level-4 (Rs. 25500-81100) or equivalent in the parent cadre/Department, or

(b) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:-

- (i) Master's Degree with Economics/Commerce/Statistics/ Business Studies/Public Administration from a recognized University/Institute.  
(ii) One year experience in handling Store and keeping Accounts in a Store or a concern of Central or State Government/Statutory or autonomous organization/PSUs/University/any recognised Institution/Banks or in a Private Sector Organization listed on the stock exchange(s) of India.

Or

(i) Bachelor's Degree in Economics/Commerce/Statistics/ Business Studies/Public Administration from a recognized University/Institute.

(ii) Diploma in Materials Management`/Warehousing Management/Purchasing/Logistics/Public Procurement

from recognised University/Institute;

(iii) Two years experience in handling Store and keeping Accounts in a Store or a concern of Central or State Government/Statutory or autonomous organization/PSUs/University/Banks or in a Private Sector Organization listed on the stock exchange(s) of India.

**Note 1:-** The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

(Period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years as on the closing date of the receipt of applications.)
