S.R.O.____ In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the Armed Forces Medical College, Artificial Limb Centre and Armed Forces Medical Stores Depots, Junior Translator (English/Hindi), Recruitment Rules, 2001, and Armed Forces Medical College, and Armed Forces Medical Stores Depots Senior Translator (English/Hindi), Recruitment Rules, 2002, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Senior Translator and Junior Translator under the Directorate General, Armed Forces Medical Services, in the Ministry of Defence, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.** - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Defence, Directorate General Armed Forces Medical Services, (Group 'B' posts) Senior Translator and Junior Translator, Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.** - The number of the said post, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in column 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc.** - The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in column 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person, -

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with person having a spouse living; or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personnel law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

<p>Promotion : From amongst Junior Translators in Level 6 (Rs. 35400-112400) in the Pay Matrix with 5 years regular service in the grade and have successfully completed the training as prescribed.</p> <p>Note 1: Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their senior shall also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or 2 years, whichever is less and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.</p> <p>Note 2: For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2016 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission. Note 3:

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.
